

# **COOKIE POLICY**

Applicable from 11 April 2025

#### 1. What is a cookie?

- 1.1. A cookie is a small data file that is stored on your computer, tablet, or smartphone when you visit a website. It is used to store information about your visit and improve your browsing experience.
- 1.2. Cookies are not programs and cannot contain or transmit harmful software or viruses.
  Furthermore, they cannot collect any information from your device, including personal data such as your name, address, or account details.

2.1 This website uses cookies which may lead to the processing of personal data. Therefore, we recommend that you read our <u>privacy policy</u>, which – among other things – describes our processing activities and your rights as a data subject.



#### 4. The website's use of cookies

- 4.1 Cookies are essential for the seamless operation of our website. They allow us to analyse your interaction with the site, facilitating ongoing enhancements tailored to your professional interests and requirements. Generally, cookies support our services by delivering content that is most pertinent to you. They play a key role in maintaining the website's efficiency, recalling your language preferences, and personalising our advertisements based on your cookie preferences.
- 4.2 On the website cookies are placed by legal A/S and third parties (third-party cookies).
- 4.3 Two types of cookies are placed:
  - Session cookies, which are stored on your device until you close your browser.
  - Persistent cookies that are stored on your device for a longer period of time. When you return to the website, the cookie is automatically renewed.
- 4.4 Prior to your consent, we set three necessary cookies in your browser, which do not contain personal data. These are the following: \_\_cf\_bm, \_\_Cfruid and messagesUtk.

Besides the three cookies, we do not set cookies without your consent.

- 4.4.1 \_\_cf\_bm is a necessary cookie that identifies and limits automated traffic, to protect the website from bots. This cookie expires after 30 minutes of continuous inactivity. The cookie is generated independently by Cloudflare and does not correspond to a user ID or other identifiers in your web application.
- 4.4.2 \_\_cfruid is needed to manage incoming traffic and to get a better overview of the type of incoming traffic to avoid bots.
- 4.4.3 messagesUtk is needed for the chat functionality to work.
- 4.5 To see the specific cookies that .legal use on the website, click on the cookie icon down in the left corner and click on "Show details". Under each of the sections below, you will see the specific cookies by unfolding the arrow.



#### 5. How long are cookies saved?

5.1 How long cookies are saved on your device can vary. The time when they are scheduled to expire is calculated from the last date you visited the website. When cookies expire, they are automatically deleted. You can view a complete list of cookies below.

## 6. This is how you can reject or delete your cookies

6.1 You can always reject cookies on your computer, tablet or phone by changing your browser settings. Where these settings can be found depends on the type of browser you are using. If you do change the settings, please be aware that there will be some functions and services that you cannot use because they rely on the website being able to remember the choices you have made.
